


Introduction – Sons of Issachar

The Sons of Issachar

Zebulon – merchants of the sea

Son of Jacob and Leah – *"he brings wages"* (1800 BC)



Issachar – students of the Torah

- Issachar is a strong donkey, lying down between two burdens; for he saw a resting place that was good. And the land that was pleasant. And he bowed his shoulder to bear, and to serve under forced labor. – Genesis 49:14-15
- Then in 1400 BC; And of Zebulon he said, Rejoice, Zebulun, in your going out; and Issachar in your tents! They shall call the peoples to the mountain; there they shall offer sacrifices of righteousness; for they shall partake of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hidden in the sands. – Deuteronomy 33:18-19

The Sons of Issachar (400 years later; 1000 BC)

1st Chronicles 12:1 – From Ziklag (recovery)...

- 1st Sam. 30:8 "pursue... you shall... recover all"
- 1st Chronicles 12:1 "the mighty men... helpers in the war"
- 1st Chronicles 12:23 to Hebron (throne)
 - "equipped for war... to turn over the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the Lord"
 - Ist Chr. 12:32 "of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their command"

<u>The Sons of Issachar were needed in a time of transition from the</u> <u>rulership of the flesh (Saul) to a greater dimension of the spirit (David)</u>

Premise #2 – <u>Principle of Self-Government</u>

Lessons 3-5 of NB and chapters 4-6 in book

- What is the origin of government?
- Why is Christianity the only religion that establishes selfgovernment as the cornerstone of liberty?
- Why was Christianity viewed by the founders of our nation as the source of *both* religious and civil liberty?

Premise #3 – The Sovereignty of God

Lessons 6-8 in the notebook; chapters 7-10 in paperback

- What does it mean that God is Sovereign?
- Why should Christ's Great Commission apply to discipling individuals and nations?
- How is God the governor among the nations?
- When is it lawful to disobey civil rulers because only God has absolute Sovereignty?

Premise #4 – Principle of Individuality

Lessons 9-11 in notebook; chapters 11-14 in paperback

- Why does God work primarily from *individuals* to groups?
- What significance is it that the individual and family are created *before* civil government?
- What is the difference between secular individualism and Biblical individuality?

Premise #5 – <u>Principle of Private Property</u> Lessons 12-13 in notebook; chapters 15-17 in paperback

- What is the origin of owning property?
- Why did the Founders consider "conscience" as the most sacred property?
- How should we steward our property and productivity to honor God and bless others?

A "Global Pause" - An Unprecedented Time

Covid-19 affects almost 100% of the globe; *God has allowed it!*

- Origin and scope of the 1950 Emergency Orders Act
- Is it a *plandemic* and is that why the healthy got quarantined?
- States / Governors reveal their priorities by what is essential
