## A Jewish Wedding foreshadows Christ and the Church


This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the Church – Ephesians 5:32


Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife. – Rev.21:9

- Betrothal covenant promise without final consummation
  - The bride <u>price</u> (dowry), paid by the groom and family
  - The bride lives with her family for a year, *preparing* to be a wife
  - The groom "prepared a place for his new bride" a *home*
  - The bride was <u>ready</u> at any time for when the groom might come
  - We are now in the <u>betrothed</u> stage of our walk with Christ!

## A Jewish Wedding foreshadows Christ and the Church

- The Wedding covenant vows and consummation
  - Bride *escorted* by her father to meet her groom under the *chuppa*
  - She would *circle* the groom three times covenant with each other
  - Wedding *banquet* would involve 7 blessings one for each day
  - There were several "choral dances" in Hebrew, "twirl & jump"
- Wine unmixed (2.5% alcoholic); "new" (no fermentation); or mixed with water... prepared by pressing grapes & aging
- Stone Jars six jars (sixth day of creation); public miracle
- God always saves the best for last!
