The New Testament Church Last Things #5 – We Shall Behold Him Pastor Paul Jehle – October 24, 2021

I The Doctrine of Last Things - Eschatology

- A. The Last Days began with Jesus' ascension Acts 1 mature the church accepting responsibility
- B. Our Church position focus on occupying until He comes, not taking a position on how
 - 1. He will return in bodily form; be prepared if He comes today or occupy until He returns
 - 2. The Return of Christ is not a rescue mission; it is the culmination of the maturity of the Church in birthing a measure of the Kingdom on earth
 - 3. The foundation for understanding prophecy is how OT predictions were fulfilled in the NT and 70 AD with the destruction of Jerusalem (Jew) and applied today (Gentiles)
 - 4. We are marked (sealed) by God as a King and a Priest, but the mark of the beast is the worship of the State (king) or Church (priest) centralized tyranny...

II The Parousia - the return of Christ

- A. The "coming" of the Lord a King returns, is greeted face to face by His people, and they reign
- B. 1st Cor. 15:50-58 at the last trumpet, dead in Christ raised, then we are changed to immortality!

III The Book of Revelation – Revelation 1:9-20

- A. John, the author, is a brother "in the tribulation" fellow sufferer Rev. 1:9-11
 - 1. In the Kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ perseverance of His Kingdom
 - 2. v. 9 "for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ" 12:11
 - a. Overcome by the blood of the lamb
 - b. Word of our testimony
 - c. Love not our lives to the death
 - 3. v. 10 "I was in the spirit on the Lord's Day" loud voice as a trumpet
 - 4. v. 11 "What you see, write in a book... and send it to the seven churches"
- A. A face to face relationship with Christ the highest form of relationship
 - 1. Deuteronomy 5:4 fire is between us and seeing God face to face and living
 - a. Genesis 33:30 Jacob wrestled with Christ "face to face" relationship
 - b. Ex. 33:11; Numbers 12:8; Dt. 34:10 Moses knew His ways (Ps 103:7)
 - 2. Psalm 80:3,7,19 Restore us, cause your face to shine (Ps. 67:1)
 - 3. 1st Cor. 13:12 now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face (know as I am known)
- B. The resurrected and coming King Jesus Christ Revelation 1:12-20
 - 1. His **voice** comes in the midst of and through the Church (seven lampstands)
 - a. The "voice of many waters" (v. 15) no one church will have it all...
 - b. God's voice will manifest through many churches different perspectives
 - 2. Clothed with a garment (righteousness) Kingdom expression (Psalm 2, 133; Mt. 22:11-14)
 - a. The garment is our character acting ethically we trust He works in others also
 - b. Multiple churches and thus a Kingdom expression of righteous living
 - 3. Head and hair white as snow (the ancient of days the Word of God eternal) Pr. 16:31
 - 4. Eves like a flame of fire He can see where no one else can see Ps. 119:8; Mt. 6:22
 - 5. Feet like fine brass (judgment of God), refined in a furnace Pr. 4:26-27; Eph. 6:
 - 6. **Right hand** seven stars (He is empowering His church with authority) Psalm 110:1
 - 7. **His mouth** went a sharp two-edged sword (Hebrews 4:12)
 - a. It separates motives, heart intent
 - b. It cuts both ways
 - 8. Countenance (face) shining in its strength genuine love and concern
