The New Testament Church Revival #11: The Gospel of the Kingdom Pastor Paul Jehle – March 27, 2022 Daniel 2:34-35; 44-45; Matthew 13:31-33

I What is Revival and when does it Come?

- A. Revival means to come alive again meaning we have grown cold and withered
- B. God uses dry hearts and a dark culture to produce desperation of hunger such as...
 - 1. **Enos** calling on the name of the Lord; **Jacob** calling on God from a place of <u>brokenness</u>
 - 2. Joseph prepared by God to preserve life and impact Egypt; Samuel bringing hope
 - 3. **Asa** and **Jehoshaphat** bringing awakening <u>and</u> reformation; **Elijah** and **Elisha** passing the torch in humility; **Jonah** embracing a heart of mercy for the lost; and **Josiah** renewing a seeking of God and His Word!
 - 4. Returns illustrate revival (Zerubbabel), awakening (Ezra), reformation (Nehemiah)
 - 5. Fire and Glory are key ingredients in Revival; we are changed by His fire and gloy

II Thy Kingdom Come – Jesus and the Kingdom; beyond the individual, family, church and experience A. What is the Gospel of the Kingdom?

- 1. Kingdom Basileia "sphere where the King rules" "where His sovereign power reigns"
- 2. Heavenly authority "My kingdom is not of this world... (John 18:36)
- 3. **Eternal -** "God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed" (Da 2:44)
- 4. "this gospel of the kingdom shall preached in all the world, and then the end" (Mt. 24:14)
 - a. A shift to an emphasis on His reign on earth the closer we get to His return
 - b. Distinct from an improper emphasis on the gospel of the church, family or benefits
- B. The manifestation of the Kingdom is the ultimate goal of revival
 - 1. "Repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand" Matthew 4:17, 10:7
 - 2. "Unless one is born again... he cannot see... or enter... the kingdom" John 3:3,5
 - 3. "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" Matthew 6:10 (prayer)
 - 4. "Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness... Matthew 6:33 kingdom priority
- C. The Kingdom comes within us (awakening)
 - 1. "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word... We will.. make Our home with him. Jn 14:23
 - 2. "For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you." Luke 17:21
 - 3. "where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there..." Matthew 18:20
- D. The Kingdom manifests on earth progressively in history (reformation)
 - 1. "if I cast out demons... the kingdom of God has come" Matthew 12:28 deliverance
 - 2. "go heal the sick... the kingdom of God has come" Luke 10:9 healing
 - 3. "You are the salt of the earth, the light of the world" Kingdom birthed through service
 - 4. "I will give you the keys of the kingdom..." church dismantles the gates of hell
 - a. Christianity is always blamed for all the ills of society... by what standard do we judge?
 - b. Rome luxury for few, rampant disease, inequality, slavery, racism & unity only in Caesar
 - c. What did the stone cut out without hands do? It crushed the image at its feet (people)
 - 1. Health care, cemeteries, a loving community, caring for one another, ideas of liberty, God-given rights, equality, unity within rather than from the State...
 - 2. Persecution demonstrated how illogical Rome actually was it exposed tyranny
 - 3. Church growth was exponential in the first century from ...
 - d. If God did it through a handful of believers in the 1st century, what might He do now?
 - 1. The growth of Bible believing Christians continues to soar around the globe!
 - 2. "fowls of the air lodge in it... till the whole was leavened" Matthew 13:31-33
 - "the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord" Revelation 11:15
