The New Testament Church *Palm Sunday and Lamb Selection Day*Pastor Paul Jehle – Palm Sunday – April 10, 2022

I The Original Lamb Selection Day and Passover – Exodus 12:3-6

- A. Nisan 10-15 the 1st month in the Jewish new year
 - 1. The Israelites needed to see that it was sin from conception that separates us from God
 - 2. It was to mark a "new beginning" out of bondage and captivity (of 400 years)
 - 3. The Passover was inseparably linked with deliverance from sin (spiritual and physical)
- B. The first Passover the 10th of Nisan was on a Saturday first Lamb Selection Day
 - 1. The Father of each family selected a lamb on that Saturday Sabbath
 - 2. The lamb had to be examined for four days by all family members; "perfect" 11th to the 14th
 - 3. It became **bonded** with the family it was no longer "a" lamb but "their" lamb
 - 4. Why? Because we were all sinners and sin must be forgiven by a blood sacrifice
 - 5. Eventually, lambs were born in Bethlehem and brought to Jerusalem through the sheep gate
 - 6. God foreshadowed in Genesis 22:8 God will provide (select) a lamb a <u>substitute</u>
 - a. On Nisan 14, at twilight, the lamb would be <u>sacrificed whole</u> no bones broken...
 - b. The **blood** was put on the doorpost; and then the Passover meal would take place
 - c. The next day, Nisan 15 a Thursday the *Exodus* took place at midnight...
 - d. Every day, the *Tamid*, morning and evening <u>sacrifice</u> (9 AM / 3 PM) Ex. 19; Lev. 6
 - 7. Joshua 4:19-24 crossed on 10th Nisan over the Jordan Gilgal stones of remembrance
 - 8. Psalms 118:21-29 states *hosanna* "save us now" *palm* branches the "flag of victory"
 - 9. Hebrew calendar by lunar months; Lamb selection and Passover fell on differing week days
- C. An eternal pattern is set it takes pressure from within and without to bring forth God's purpose
 - 1. Romans 8:18-23 due to sin, the bringing forth of Christ, and His Church, is pressure
 - 2. Birth-pangs of suffering, pain, grief and difficulty will accompany the Kingdom coming

II Palm Sunday; Lamb Selection Day - Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-47; John 12:12-19

- A. Lamb Selection Day Jesus came to fulfill the Law Mt. 5:17-19 He is our Passover Lamb!
 - 1. Matthew 21-28; Mark 11-16; Luke 19:28-24 (40%) and John 12:12-21 (66%)
 - 2. As the cross and resurrection approach, the intensity increases each day of passion week
- B. In the year that Jesus died Nisan 10 fell on a Sunday God the Father chose our Lamb
 - 1. Jesus cross over Jordan on the 10th, through Jericho to Jerusalem Sheep's gate
 - 3. He was intensely examined publicly four days in the Temple some hated; others bonded
 - 4. But now only the wealthy chose their lambs; the common people got them from the Priests
 - 5. The cry of *Hosanna*! with palms was both spiritual and physical cry for liberty extra patrols
 - 6. Christ rides on a donkey fulfilling Zech 9:9 through the Sheep Gate! (Lambs inspected)
 - 7. On Monday the children cried Hosanna the "stones of remembrance" will cry out"
 - 8. He cleansed the Temple that evening... He was the lamb, stopped the monetary control
 - a. The religious bureaucracy had taken the role of choosing both lambs and people!
 - b. Barred more people from the Temple than allowed in; it became people inspection day!
 - c. Jesus cast out money-changers and declared the temple a house of prayer for all nations
- B. Christ the fulfillment of the Passover...
 - 1. Examined by every segment of society in what he taught (Monday through Thursday); He was found perfect his authority, tribute to Caesar, Offerings, resurrection, greatest command...
 - 2. As families bonded with their personal lamb so the common people did with their Savior
 - 3. As families had their lambs tied to the altar and then killed they had no idea that the morning
 - (9 AM) and afternoon (3 PM) sacrifice for atonement would now be the one true Lamb of God!
 - 4. He was offered whole not one bone was broken as prophesied!
