Titus 1:1-5

I Introduction to the Book of Titus

- A. Island of Crete mountainous OT mentions it as Caphtor, home of Philistines
 - 1. Located off the coast of Greece (150 miles long, 8 to 35 miles wide)
 - 2. Founded by Phoenicians by 1500 BC
 - 3. Home of Jupiter? Greek gods, Minos was his son (Minoan civilization)
 - a. Greek civilization created "god" in man's image
 - b. They also rejected absolutes greed, theft, immorality most corrupt place?
 - 4. The Book of Acts (2:11) mentions Cretans on the day of Pentecost
 - a. It is possible that some of these individuals were converted
 - b. They (Jewish believers) may have started churches on the island...
 - 5. Paul could have gone to Crete after Acts 28 (released from prison) or it may not have been mentioned by Luke for some reason
 - 6. By 67 AD, when Titus would have been there, it was governed by Rome
- B. Who was Titus?
 - 1. One of two key disciples of Paul Timothy (Jewish) and Titus (Greek)
 - 2. Titus had worked with the Apostle Paul in Corinth and Dalmatia

II Titus 1:1-5

- A. Paul bondservant (voluntary slave) of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ
 - 1. According to the faith of God's elect (calling must also have character)
 - 2. And the acknowledgement of the truth which accords with godliness
 - 3. In hope of eternal life which God (an eternal perspective is critical)
 - 4. Who cannot lie, promised before time began (gifts and calling irrevocable)
- B. In due time it was manifested incarnated through preaching
 - 1. The Word of God Old Testament; main method through preaching/teaching
 - 2. Committed to me according to the commandment of God our Savior
- C. To Titus, a true son in our common faith
 - 1. When someone leads you to the Lord, you are their "son or daughter in the faith"
 - 2. Though you are not "under" them with any obligation,
 - 3. You ought to honor who led you to the Lord part of your spiritual heritage
- D. To whom do we give glory to for all of this? God...
 - 1. Grace ability given getting what we don't deserve
 - 2. Mercy unmerited favor not getting what we do deserve
 - 3. And peace from harmony in relationships
 - 4. God the Father sovereign over all
 - 5. and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior
- E. The reason I left you in Crete was that you might straighten out what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town Titus 1:5
 - 1. The church did not have the foundations it needed to transform the culture
 - 2. The book will reveal the foundational truths needed to transform a godless culture
 - 3. This is timely now, for we see parallels of our slide toward such a culture as Crete
