## The New Testament Church The Purpose of Pentecost – The Feast of Pentecost - Acts 1:1-11 Pastor Paul Jehle – May 21, 2023

## I The Feasts of Israel and their Fulfillment

- A. The Feast of Passover Exodus 12 Born again new life in Christ sovereign regeneration
  - 1. It marks the "first da of the new year" father selects a lamb, family bonds with it 4 days
  - 2. Barley in the head (but not ripe) feast of unleavened bread (Jesus our Passover Lamb)
- B. Pentecost (Ex. 17-20; Lev. 23:15-21; Num. 28:26-31; Dt. 16:9-12) empowered to keep covenant
  - 1. Pentecost means "50<sup>th</sup>" Moses ascends at 40 days, brings Law at 50<sup>th</sup> day by power!
  - 2. Jesus imparted the Holy Spirit to disciples after resurrection, then on 50<sup>th</sup> day empowerment!
- C. The Feast of Tabernacles God tabernacling with His people first Christ, then the Church
  - 1. To announce (feast of trumpets) last month of the year 7<sup>th</sup> month (September-October)
  - 2. Day of Atonement goat (sacrifice and scapegoat) restoration of all things Christ's return!

## II The Feast of Pentecost – the "evidence" of God at work – a holy covenant (ekklesia)

- A. Preparation for Pentecost directly linked to Passover foreshadowing entering into covenant
  - 1. Water from a Rock for 2+ million with "evidence" baptized into Moses (1st Cor. 10:2)
  - 2. The power of sacrificial worship Amalekites raising Moses' hands battle is the Lord's
  - 3. Self-rule by teaching the Word (law) Jethro, Moses' father in law put Israel in order
- B. A holy covenant to be both priests (vertical) and kings (horizontal) Israel said "yes" (Ex. 19:8)
  - 1. Moses ascends the mountain on the 40<sup>th</sup> day gets instructions from God (Ex. 19:10-11)
  - a. Consecration wash clothes be prepared to meet God (from afar) Jesus' death
    - b. Set boundaries around the mountain and called to the base by a trumpet
  - 2. Foreshadowing the instructions for keeping the Feast of Pentecost Exodus 19:16-19
    - a. Bring two loaves of bread two tables of the Law-Word the thunder voice of God
      - 1. The first alphabet (alpha-beta in Greek; aleph-bet in Hebrew) individual sounds
      - 2. Israelites took Dt. 11:24 and Josh. 1:3 seriously every place you walk (sole of foot)!
      - 3. Other nations borrowed from Israel and literacy and science exponentially increased
    - b. Sacrifice made by fire (cleansing) commitment to change transformed into His character
      - 1. Sin and peace offerings humility is being conscious of your need for Christ
      - 2. Offerings are made by fire 1st Cor. 14:21-22 (Is. 28:11-12) judgment on sin
      - 3. This is why prayer language tongues "fans the flame" for our own cleansing, and
      - 4. Public tongues (with interpretation) are a sign that a substitute for sin has already come!
    - c. Waved before the Lord to the Glory of God holy to the Lord made new water/cloud
      - 1. May the Lord have us do all things "for His glory" and not our own Psalm 115:1
      - 2. Be Holy as He is Holy Matthew 5:48 and 1st Peter 1;16 His holiness...
- C. The Feast of Pentecost parallels with the Old Testament and fuilfilled in the New Testament
  - 1. Mt. Sinai (the Law) and Mt. Zion (the Spirit) Passover led directly to Pentecost (covenant)
  - 2. Moses ascended Sinai at 40 days after Passover; Jesus ascended 40 days after Passover
  - 3. The Law "written by the finger of God"; then "on our hearts" Jeremiah 31:31-34
  - 4. Voice of God "thundered" on Sinai, and it spoke with tongues of fire at Pentecost
  - 5. Three thousand died at Sinai; three thousand converted at Pentecost Acts 2:41
  - 6. Sinai thundered with judgment; but now that Christ has come, we are welcome Heb. 12:18ff
  - 7. God still shakes the earth but now our goal is the establishment of His Kingdom Heb. 12:25ff
- D. Missions; the Purpose of Pentecost Acts 1:8 Israel's mission at Sinai; Church's at Pentecost
- 1. Receive power (empower by the Spirit) to be witnesses (in the Greek; martyrs)
  - 2. Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and to the end of the earth inside-out the Kingdom grows!
  - 3. Christianity has continued to grow; and the Kingdom is advancing world-wide!
  - 4. Of the 17,400 people groups, 7,400 are unreached (less than 2% believers); or 43%!
