I God is Building a Family Business (Introduction and Chapter 1) – PP slides 1-4

- A. <u>The Garden of Eden was the first business</u>; God the owner, Adam and Eve the partners.
 - 1. Genesis 2:15 Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend (labor) and keep (manage) it.
 - 2. Webster's 1828 Employment; that which occupies the time, attention and labor of men, for the purpose of profit or improvement.
 - 3. Business is about an exchange of values between two or more parties (p. xiii)
- B. God is the Creator of Private Property
 - 1. Psalm 24:1 *The Earth is the Lord's and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.* In other words, God is the original and sovereign owner of all private property!
 - 2. Psalm 115:16 ...but the earth He has given to the children of men. we are stewards
 - 3. *If you are in Christ, you are called to extend His kingdom franchise on Earth as a junior partner* every occupation is full-time Christian service (p. 3, quotes from pgs. 13-14)

II Maturity comes by Stewarding Property (Chapters 2-3) – PP slide 5 - p. 17

- A. We grow by caring for people and things Matthew 25:23
 - 1. God calls us to steward our personal responsibility and initiative (Pr. 25:28)
 - 2. We will give account for our *bodies* (long life), *conscience* (attitudes toward stewardship), *relationships* (building together), *talents* (producing proprietors), *possessions* (character generates profit) we *increase* each area... (quotes p. 19-20)
- B. All lasting wealth comes through the family unity and is built generationally Pr. 13:22
 - 1. Riches are something we have, whereas wealth is something we are $-\,\mathrm{p.}\ 32$
 - 2. What do you want the next generation to inherit? Debt or wealth? (1st Tim. 6:17-19)
 - 3. Five categories of wealth stewardship we should leave our children pgs. 45-47; p. 47

III God loves to Work (Chapters 4-5) – PP slide 6

- A. Work is a holy, everlasting Calling Genesis 2:15; 2nd Thessalonians 3:10
 - 1. God is a creator, worker and entrepreneur Genesis 1-2
 - 2. Heaven will be a sin-free work environment! Revelation 21
 - 3. More should be required of a believer in the workplace Luke 12:48 (p. 59)
- B. Service is the foundation of all lasting Growth Matthew 23:11
 - 1. The best way to make a business profitable is to have as many proprietors and as few employees as possible pg. 64
 - 2. Employees focus on their rights whereas leaders focus on their responsibilities pg. 69
 - 3. Capitalism is built on greed and socialism is built on entitlement. (p. 70)

IV What Money reveals about People (Chapters 6-7) – PP slide 7

- A. God pays for what He orders 1st Timothy 6:10 (love of money is gluttony)
 - 1. Fallacies: money solves problems; and if you run out, print or borrow more. (p. 75)

- 2. God has all resources, so He distributes a portion to those who can manage it
- 3. Inflation is theft, and debt for consumption is bondage (slavery) Pr. 22:7-9 (p. 87)
- B. Risk, Self-respect and redemptive Struggle Galatians 6:7
 - 1. God designed spiritual choices to be seen in the material world see page 89
 - 2. Risk teaches us through failure, self-respect comes by reaping what you sow p. 92-94
 - 3. Eight cocoon-cutting policies destroying the Nation pages 98-99

V Exposing the Cruelty of the Economics of Blame (Chapters 8-9) – PP slides 8-11

- A. <u>Ideas and actions have Economic Consequences</u> Ephesians 4:28; Pr. 12:10, p. 103
 - 1. We live in a design dominated universe as we think internally, so we are (Pr. 22:7)
 - 2. Avoid a poverty/prosperity; don't blame the environment or others p. 107-109
 - 3. Destroy the five enemies within and replace them with humility p. 111-118
- B. <u>Justice and Equality are not the same</u> Psalm 89:14 p. 119
 - 1. "Equality" is dressed up envy. (Genesis 3:5)
 - 2. Example of equality and taxation p. 125 (Pr. 12:10) compassion of wicked/cruel
 - 3. Life is not fair, and the ministry of civil government is justice all play by same rules
 - 4. See illustrations and quotes on a greater clarity of Equality.

VI Godly Government produces Peace and Productivity – (Chapters 10-11) – PP slides 12-13

- A. <u>Functional biblical government is essential for productivity</u> 1st Timothy 2:1-3
 - 1. The Trinity is the model in heaven of unity and diversity in business
 - 2. God is the source of human rights see chart on page 134 5 spheres of government
 - 3. Our philosophy of government either stimulates or retards human creativity p. 136
- B. The Essential three-fold Cords that will lead to your Success Ecclesiastes 4:12
 - 1. True Christianity is about information that leads to transformation. p.143
 - a. One Only disciples change the world: Are you living like one? p. 145-146
 - b. Two Building a Christian worldview: have you started the task? p. 147
 - c. Three Working together strategically to execute God's plan for the Nations: Wil you start where you have influence? p. 149-150
 - 2. Honesty, Competency and the Capacity to be trained p. 150

VII <u>A Call to True Radicals</u> – (Chapter 12) – PP slide 14

- A. <u>Discover the root structures and build out from them</u> a true radical Isaiah 58:12
 - 1. A radical understands root principles that change from the bottom p. 153-154
 - 2. True radicals build on God's laws and principles
 - 3. Practicing the basics are critical to maturing in every area of life
- B. Six Essential Laws for Rebuilding a Culture p. 158-160
 - 1. Personal Initiative: All true freedom begins in self-government
 - 2. Healthy Families: The family unit is the basic building block of society
 - 3. Effective Churches: *The local church is the primary equipping center for service*4. Private Property: *The stewardship of private property is essential to societal maturity*

 - 5. Problem Solving: Rebuilding a nation begins with rebuilding local communities
