The 250th Anniversary of
The Declaration of Independence

Since 1988, The New Testament Church has celebrated the birth of our nation each year with a Christian Heritage Sunday. We have attempted to restore the tradition practiced throughout our nation's history – celebrating the fruit of liberty by commemorating its biblical roots! For years churches rehearsed the roots of our nation's public documents, especially the Declaration of Independence. We honor that today with our 38th annual Christian Heritage Sunday on this Semiquincentennial of our nation's birth certificate!

Our celebration of the 4th of July goes back to the beginning of our church's history. In 1961 an authentic Revere bell was donated to the Cedarville Baptist Church (as we were known then) by Alfred Nye, who also donated the land upon which our present church was built. This bell (in our belfry) is engraved with the date July 4, 1901, commemorating the year our church was born. This has symbolized for us the enduring mission of our church to proclaim the Gospel as well as rehearse the heritage of liberty in our nation that has arisen from it. It was Grace Nye's (Alfred's wife) generous donation upon her death that allowed us to expand our facility in 1999.

Today we honor our public servants, veterans, and each of those attending as we remember our heritage and its importance. May we honor the source of our liberty – the sovereign God who reigns above and those who pledged, and still pledge, their lives, fortunes and sacred honor!
